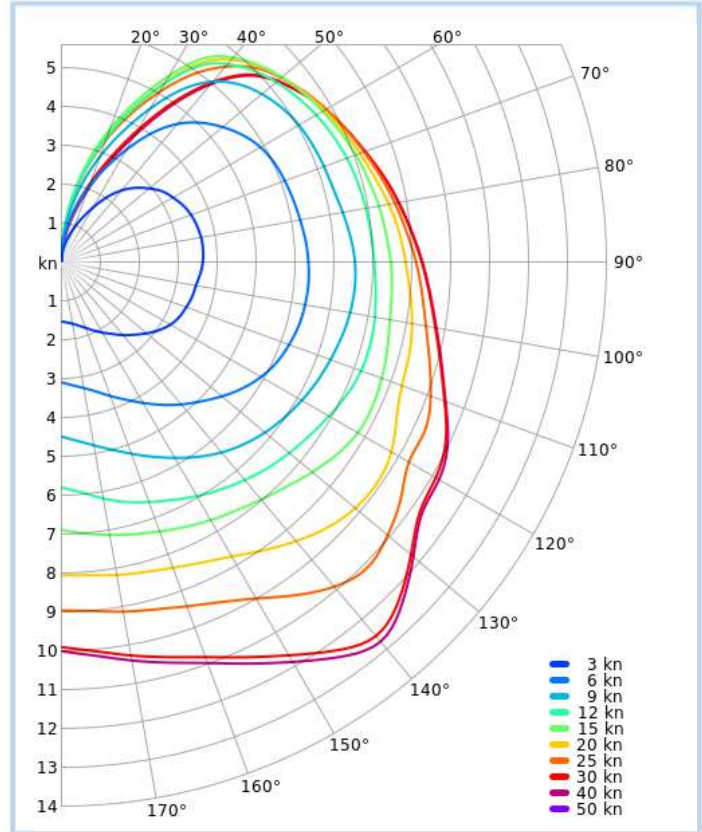

SOL RACE RECORD

Denmark's Niels Jeppesen designed his first X in 1979, the X-79, which was 7.9m long. The atomic number of gold is 79, and the X-79 was a huge success. Go figure! Two years later, the X-102 was conceived, like Finnulf's FG34 as an entry for 3/4 ton cup. The X-102 won, establishing X-Yachts as a no-nonsense high performance yacht brand internationally.

Twenty odd years and many many designs later, the X-35 came off Niels' drawing board. At 10.6m LOA not dissimilar to the iconic 102 of the 80s, the 35 has enjoyed great popularity, and, in fact, has become one of only a handful of ISAF-recognized one-design offshore racing yachts.
