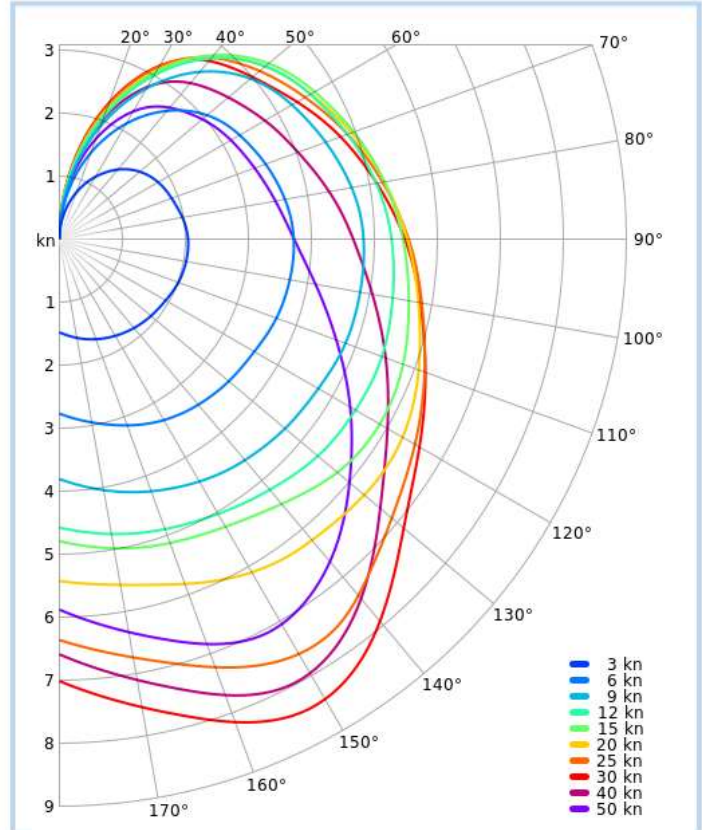

Family-owned Dyer Boats have been building their 9-foot dhows for over 60 years. Designed by Philip Rhodes as a multi-purpose yacht tender, rescue and small sailing craft, the Dyer Dhow has become the boat of choice for numerous frostbite clubs along the US East Coast between New York and Boston, including the Mamaroneck Frostbite Association (MFA), who count several SOLers as members.

Our online polar, developed by SOLer wsguerin, shows how in a good breeze on a broad reach, the boat will plane. "IRL this is a wild and scary ride but in a SOL race.." says ws, and recommends you click on the [video link](#) and note the temperature.

Close racing between up to 30 boats, usually split into A and B fleets, is a hallmark of MFA frostbiting. "Knowledge of rules, your weight placement, and a bit of trash talk is essential", adds ws. Let's see how she SOLs.
