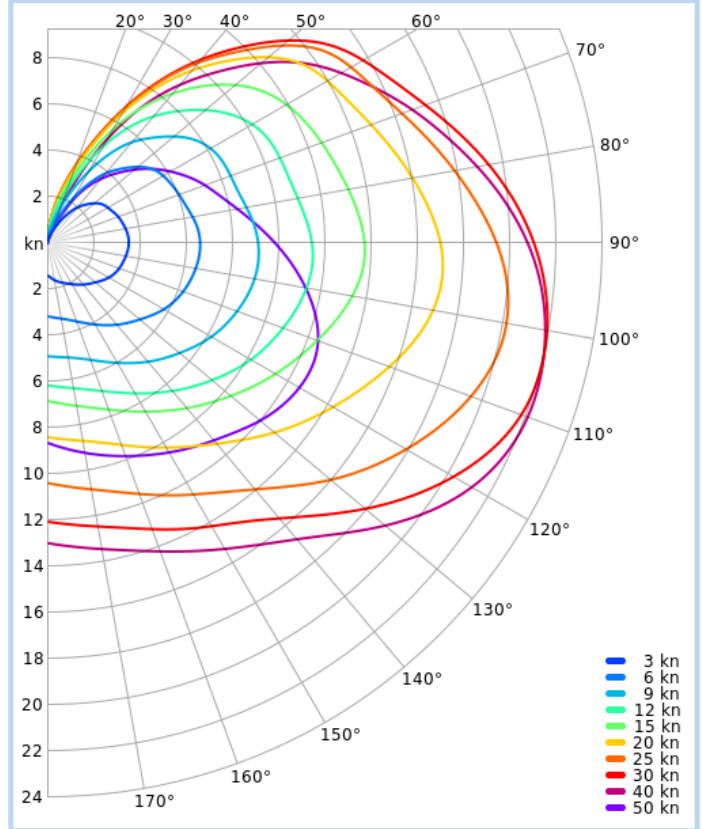

Lagoon were one of the first mass producers to jump on this new bandwagon, first as a subsidiary of Jeanneau and then later of Beneteau. Over time, around 50ft became the dominant LOA of the various models from Lagoon, Pajot Fontaine, Antares and Outremer to name but a few.
