

When I set start time for the race I checked when the strongest wind and the best wind angle during the race should occur.

For the first leg it was most important because its length, and I calculated when the windangle would be nearly 135 dgrs. At the leg after Rocky Bay Buoy sassy had to tack twice, and I tacked when sassy gained 100% performance and not before.

When sassy got to Te Miro Bay tacked once up north to Ahaaha Rocks. After that it was just downwind to the three remaining waypoints and then to finish.

Sassy had Tupsu chasing all the way to the finish, and with 24 seconds margin sassy managed to stay ahead.
