SPRINT (SRQ1)

Five races in the quarter = four different winners and many different boats finishing at least once in TOP TEN . This says a lot about two things :

- 1) The field in Sprints is a lot more level than in other races.
- 2) In Sprints one mistake is never forgiven ;)

Before the start of the last race the Q1 final leadership was almost a private matter between Bonknhoot and WINSTON_4 , the latter leading by six solid points. Bonk managed to race almost at best , and remained in the very top group all the way . WINSTON trashed the race and the quarter Championship with one mistake in the very early part of the last race.....recovered slightly...and in the end the above rule N.2 was fully confirmed. Bonknhoot got the quarter by the same number of solid points = 6 !!

In all the Sprint races have seen an increase of participation vs the immediate past , and this let hope for good in the immediate future.

A total of 303 boats participated to at least one SPRINT Championship race in Q1 , and 124 of them qualified for Series rankings Q1.
