Before it needed two extra tacks that are bad for performance, after it was longer route and windshift starting to work, would have needed to sail lower than max VMG, polar not giving really big perf boost so decided very late to tack before it.

That was propably key for victory even though was in very good spot before it too. At the end managed to beat second boat by half minute what is quite a big margin for a sprint. Thank's all, this race was dedicated to YachtYakka.
