The second quarter of 2016 has seen two totally different games on the SOL oceans!

The first race resulted as one of the most interesting runs ever: Melbourne to Osaka demanded high patience and great skills, together with a bit of courageous decisional ability. The name of the game had been where to get across the minefield spread in the Salomon Sea to enter the open waters of the South Pacific Ocean. The ancient "In medio stat virtus" philosophy ruled once again. In the open some changes in WX gave further opportunities to small groups, but in general the race was won or lost in the crossing.

The second race (Jester Challenge) will be remembered as the slowest ocean race with the slowest ever boat , and really did not give any moment of real excitement , not even when finally the fleet found some 25/30/35 knots of strong breeze. In this second case the patience concept was that of being able to get to the finish line.

By pure means of consistent performance WINSTON_4 secured the OCQ2 with a 3rd and a 4th place overall.
