




SOL RACE RECORD

Long, long ago, The Observer newspaper sponsored a Single-handed Transatlantic Ocean Race, conceived by WWII veteran "Blondie" Hasler, DSO, OBE. By the early 80s, what had originally been a race for amateur mavericks in sturdy monohulls had become a maxi multihull fest. The OSTAR became the CSTAR sponsored by Carlsberg, and the race split into two: a race for multihulls – mostly Tri 60s; and a race for monohulls - mostly Open 60s.

But Hasler's original concept lived on and in 2005, the OSTAR returned as The Original STAR, for yachts of up to 50ft. Repeating every four years, the typical entrant is a modified 35ft monohull. SOL's OSTAR35 has a polar based on a mix of these types of yachts. Conceived in cooperation between SOLers 76Trombones and Alabama Queen, SOL's OSTAR35, like the race, continues to go from strength to strength, as can be seen at the Racelist below.
