
SSANZ Safety at Sea Two-Handed Triple Series 2017 - Race 2



Coming away from Motutapu Island Island, fastpassage and I were battling close behind Kipper.

They both headed south, while I stayed north as we headed back towards Auckland. I had more wind, but thev favourable wind shift and one gybe to my two. I initially was headed for the north end of the line, but made a decision at the last minute to head for the south end. That might have made all difference, as it was just a few seconds in the end that separated the three podium positions.
