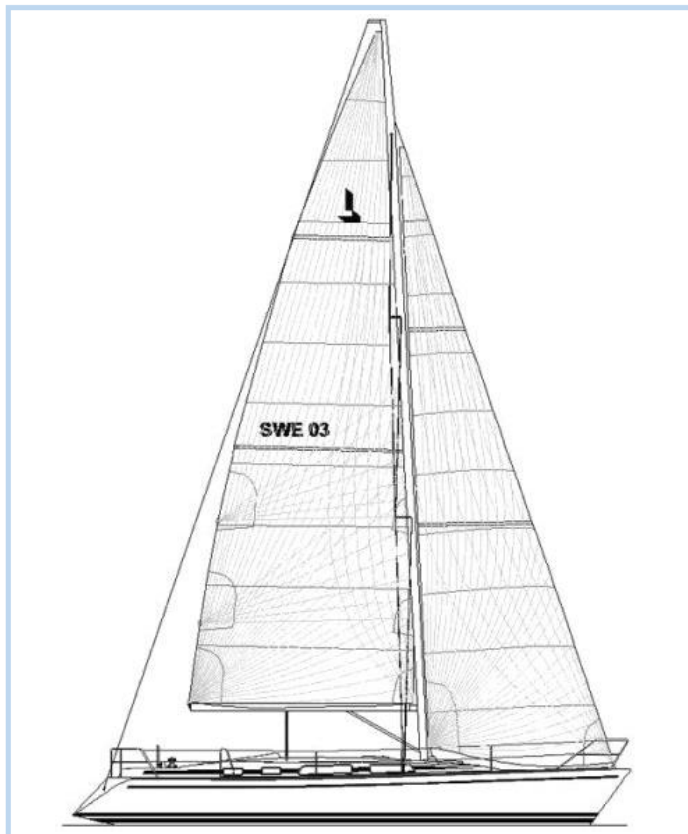


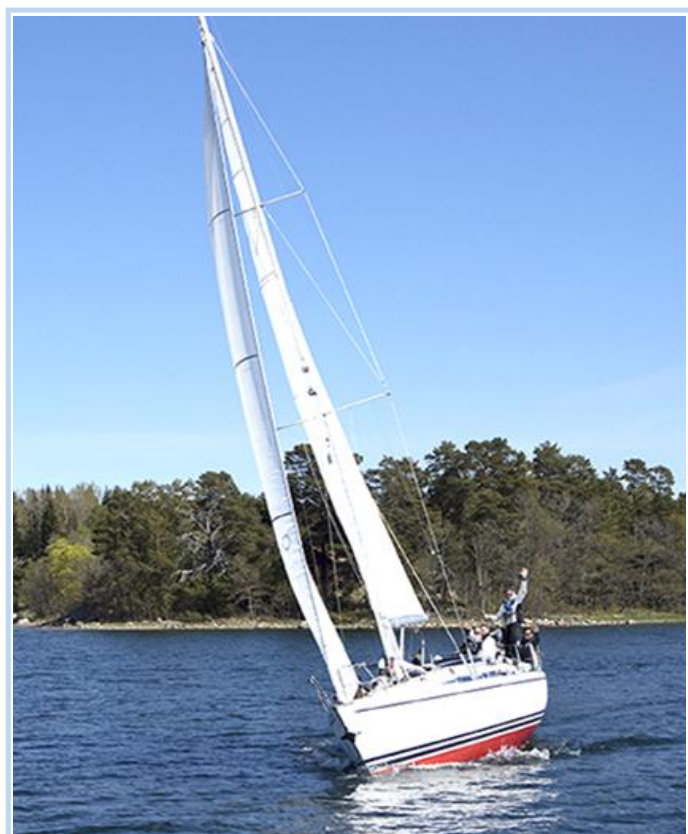

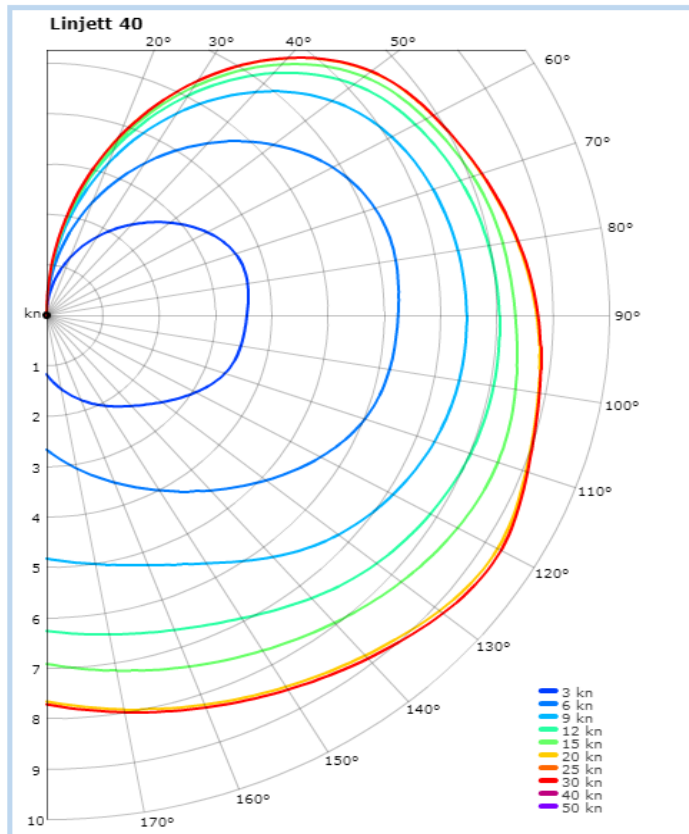

SOL RACE RECORD

Rosättra Båttvarv at the head of the Norrtäljeviken in Sweden has remained a family business right up until today, and Mats Gustavsson, great-great-grandson of the first generation founders, has been the yard's in-house designer across the 90s and the 00s of a long stable of Linjetts, ranging in length from 30ft to 45ft, many of them still in production.

The Linnjet 40, which came of Mats' drawing board in 2002, is a good example of the yard's yachting concepts, aimed squarely at the local home market (the website is in Swedish only). Moderate draft and a very sturdy rudder frame for safe and sure rock-hopping through the Archipelago plus a high-end interior attest to this. Inducted into the Sailonline boathouse in 2014, she is a pretty ship with a good turn of speed upwind despite her shallow draft.
