Rankings by Nation Quarterly update from SRC 2020 end of Q1

At the end of First Quarter 2020, or 23 races in all, we can look at a "provisional" situation strong enough to promise little change during the rest of the year, but also able to see fierce fighting for top spots and medals. Again this year there is a substantial change of "actors "in the top rankings both Individual and Team.

In Detail:

INDIVIDUAL: The Netherlands and Poland leading the ranks (6 and 5 victories each), chased at distance by a pack of 9 Nations with 2 and 1 victory each.

SKIPPER: (For medals)

As most of you are by now aware we have in place a scheme aimed to reward that Skipper (Individual) or those Three Skippers (Team) who more than others have contributed to the final position of his/her/their National Flag in the Rankings by Nation. The scheme rewards participation as well as results.

We are now in the position, at the end of this first quarter, to simulate which Skippers would be rewarded **IF** the situation would be that of year end 2020:

INDIVIDUAL SKIPPER:

The Netherlands as you have seen is in **GOLD** position. The Dutch Skipper with more points than any other one is **bonknhoot**, with 100 points. If this will be the result at the end of

2020 he would receive a large Gold Medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

Poland is today in **SILVER** position. The Polish Skipper with more points than any other one is **WRmirekd**, with 126 points. If this will be the result at the end of 2020 he would receive a large Silver Medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

Peru is for now in **BRONZE** position, and the (lonely but Grande Maestro) Peruvian Skipper is **rafa** with 95 points. If this will be the result at the end of 2020 he would receive a large Bronze Medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

Hopefully reading the above simulation everyone will enjoy a better understanding of the Skippers reward mechanicals for Nations Rankings. (Individual)

TEAM SKIPPERS:

Australia is leading the Team rankings and the three skippers with best "Australian Team by Nation" score are: **Kipper1258 (465)**, **Tyger (298) and Dingo (205)**. If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Gold large medal for Team rankings by Nation for Australia's victory in the scheme.

The Netherlands is in SILVER at the moment, and the three Skippers with best "Dutch" Team score are: bonknhoot (332), festinalente (213) and splitpen (205). If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Silver large medal for Team rankings by Nation for The Netherlands's second place in the scheme.

USA is in BRONZE position at the moment, and the three skippers with best "US" Team score are: **Garagiste (291), Starship (286) and CollegeFund (200)**. If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Bronze large medal for Team rankings by Nation for USA's third place in the scheme.

Hopefully reading the above simulation everyone will enjoy a better understanding of the Skippers reward mechanicals for Nations Rankings. (Team)
