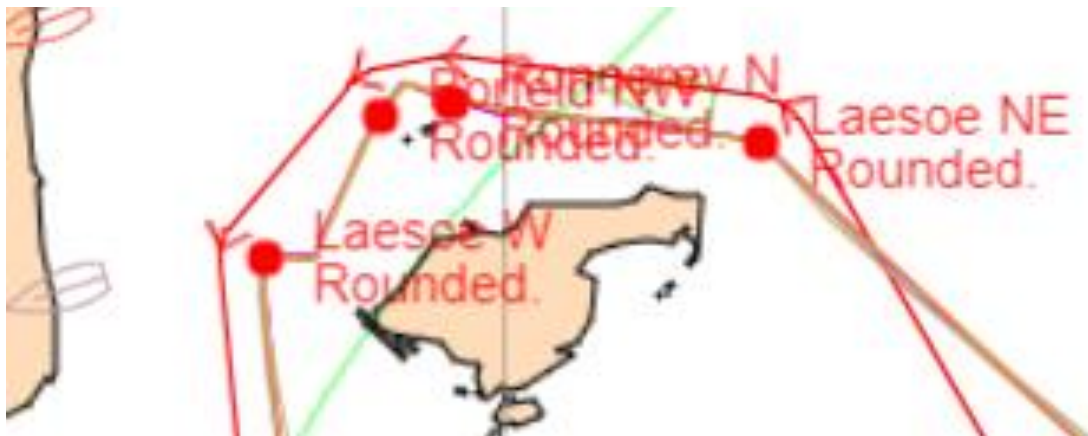
In our races, however, it is something completely different. Pure mathematics. But it's nice to mention that in IRL was there.

But, fortunately, I set the alarm and woke up at the last minute. You can see my madness here.

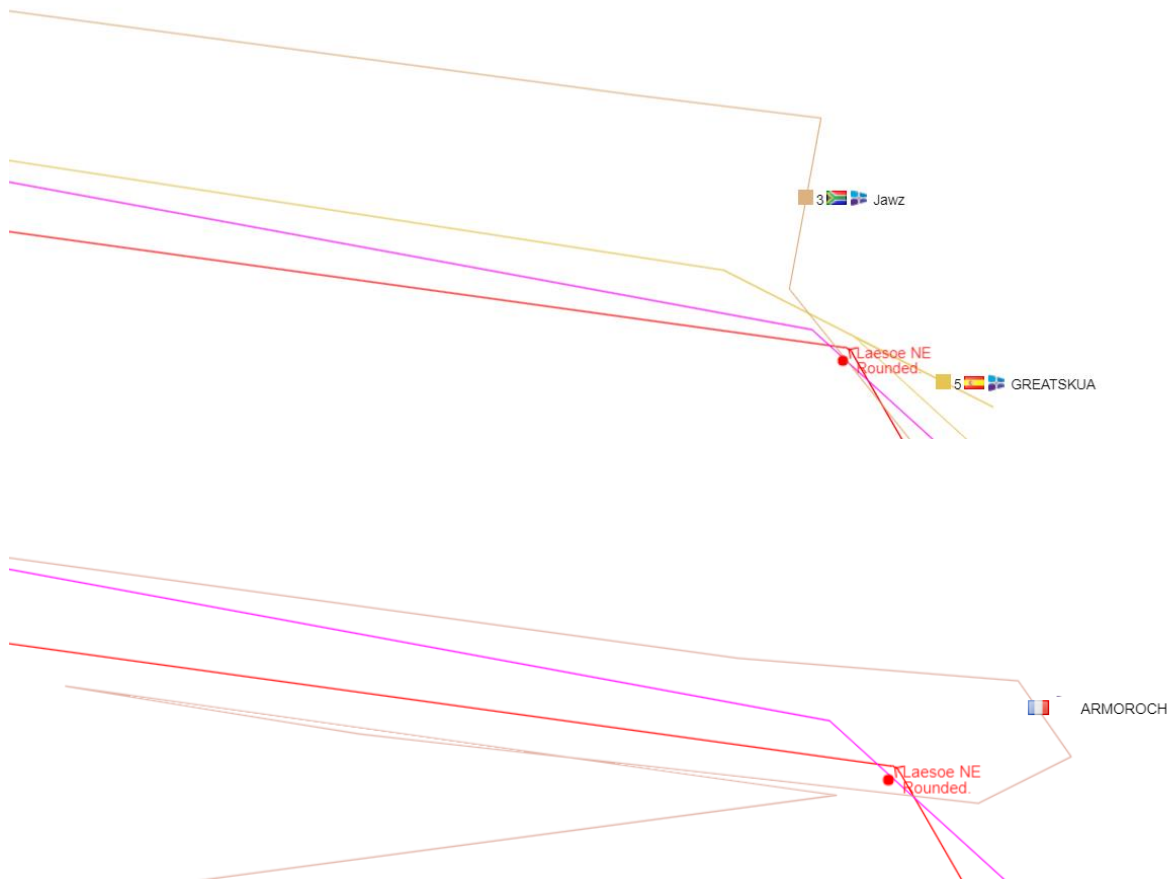


However, I was very lucky.

I was wondering if I'm the only unlucky person?

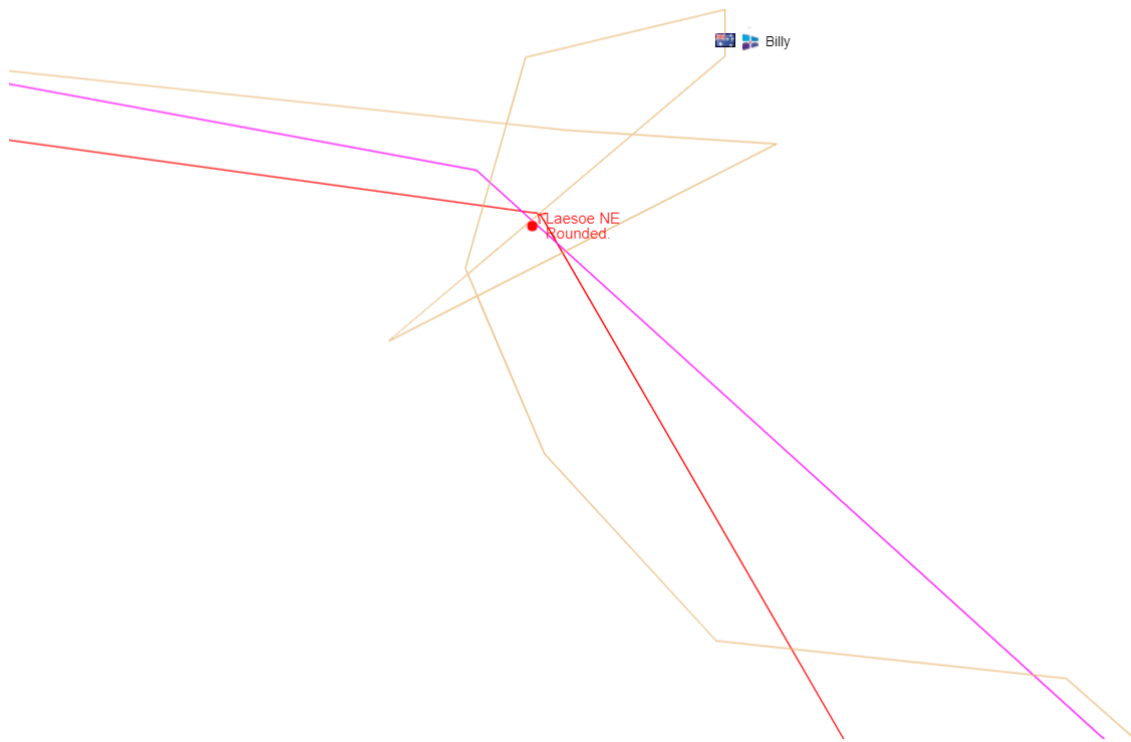
It turned out that more terrible things happened on "Laesoe NE" and I am only a minor accident.
