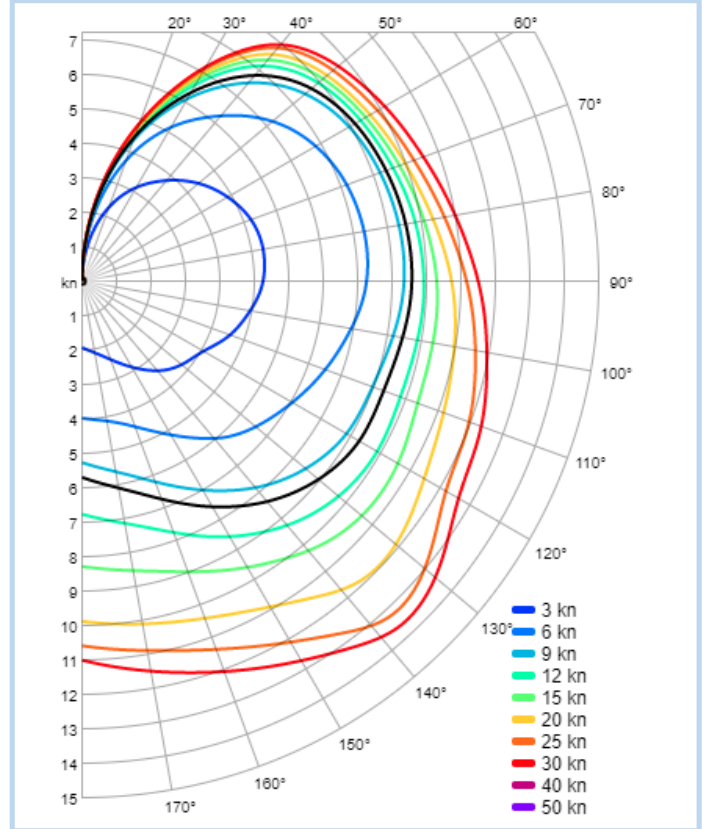

Denmark's Niels Jeppesen designed his first X in 1979, the X-79, which was 7.9m long. The atomic number of gold is 79, and the X-79 was a huge success. Go figure! Three years later his X-102 won the 3/4 Ton Cup in 1981.

Success breeds success, and over the many years since then one successful X after another came off the drawing board with four (at time of writing) making into the SOL boatyard-of-fame. In recent years, a new line of Xp's have started to hit the water with the 'p' standing for performance, and the Xp-55 is currently (2020) the yard's flagship.
