Rankings by Nation Quarterly update from SRC 2020 end of Q2

At the end of the second Quarter 2020, or 48 races in all, we can look at a "provisional" situation that seems to have fixed both the podiums (Individual and Team), if it wasn't for the fact that we are only half way through the run, and everything is still possible. Within the top three spots the fight both individual and Team has increased in momentum and the result promises to be highly uncertain till the very end of the year.

In Detail:

INDIVIDUAL: Poland, thanks to a super-performance in Q2 is keeping at safe distance the two runner ups **The Netherlands** and **Australia**. Being the numbers 12, 9 and 8, everything can still happen up there. The 4th in line (Italy) has 4 points, or half of the 3rd one.

Behind the top four there is fight between 10 nations with one or two points.

TEAM: Very similar situation in the Team fight:

Australia has managed to keep at distance the two runner ups , **USA** and **Italy.** They have respectively 15, 11 and 7 points. This means that here again everything is still possible.

Behind , with from 1 to 4 points there is not much chance , other than that of grabbing perhaps the third spot on podium . Future will tell.

SKIPPER: (For medals)

Everyone is by now aware that also in 2020 we have in place a scheme aimed to reward that Skipper (Individual) or those Three Skippers (Team) who more than others have contributed to the final position of his/her/their National Flag in the Rankings by Nation . The scheme rewards participation as well as results.

We are now in the position, at the end of this second quarter, to simulate which Skippers would be rewarded **IF** the situation would be that of year end 2020:

INDIVIDUAL SKIPPER:

Poland as you have seen is in **GOLD** position. The Polish Skipper with more points than any other one is **WRmirekd**, with 236 points. If this will be the result at the end of 2020 he would receive a large Gold Medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

The Netherlands is today in **SILVER** position. The Dutch Skipper with more points than any other one is **bonknhoot** with 196 points. If this will be the result at the end of 2020 he would receive a large SILVER medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

Australia is at this time in **BRONZE** position, and the Australian Skipper with best score over other Australians, in as far as individual results is **Kipper1258** with 152 points. If this will be the result at the end of 2020 he would receive a large Bronze Medal to record his achievement in the Rankings by Nation (Individual).

Hopefully reading the above simulation everyone will enjoy a better understanding of the Skippers reward mechanicals for Nations Rankings. (Individual)

TEAM SKIPPERS:

Australia is leading the Team rankings and the three skippers with best "Australian Team by Nation" score are: Kipper1258 (911), Dingo (655) and Tyger (449). If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Gold large medal for Team rankings by Nation for Australia's victory in the scheme.

USA is in SILVER at the moment, and the three Skippers with best "American" Team score are: **Starship (577)**, **Garagiste (468) and CollegeFund (279)**. If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Silver large medal for Team rankings by Nation for USA's second place in the scheme.

Italy is presently in BRONZE position, and the three skippers with best "Italian" Team score are: **brandystrega** (507), AL53_SSIta (322) and geduio (317). If we were now at year's end these three skippers would receive (each) a Bronze large medal for Team rankings by Nation for Italy's third place in the scheme.

Hopefully reading the above simulation everyone will enjoy a better understanding of the Skippers reward mechanicals for Nations Rankings. (Team)

The final rankings by Nation (Individual) would be:

AND

The final rankings by Nation (Team) would be:

and the Skippers to take the medals would be:

GOLD	Kipper1258 - Dingo - Tyger
SILVER	Starship - Garagiste - CollegeFund
BRONZE	brandystrega - AL53_SSIta - geduio
