The island also has a Polish accent.


One of the great Polish patriots, General Ignacy Prądzyński, was buried here.





But it's time to get back to the race. An analysis of the previous weather forecasts indicated that the race would be settled to **Skagen**. The second part of the route from **Skagen** to the finish line did not give practically the possibility of changing the ranking.

The start itself is always a big mystery to me. Literally 5 minutes before the start I decided to finally pass **Düne** on port side. Most stayed on the starboard side. However, this was not what decided about my victory, although I planned to get the lead at the beginning of the race with this maneuver.



Despite all due diligence when planning the start, I cannot achieve the desired effect and **Rafa** is the start master. How does he do it? After the first turns, I was probably 5th behind **Rafa**, **Bonknhoot**, **Nacrr**, **Rumskib**. Strong players themselves



I got to work hard and to my pleasant surprise before **Thyborøn Kanal** I was already in second position just behind **Bonknhoot**.


The loss was small, but there were not many opportunities to make up for it.

I came up with a plan and hoped that **Bonknhoot** would not come up with it and by making a mistake he would allow me to take the lead.

**Nørre Vorupør** and **Klitmoller**. Two strategic places for me. Close to shore the TWD it was better but the TWS was smaller. I had to carefully analyze how these two indicators are changing on the way to Skagen. The router, depending on its settings, showed different variants.

Basically, there were four variants:

- 1. Stay with heading north in stronger winds and in a less favorable his direction.
- 2. Turn ashore at Nørre Vorupør and continue without turning at Klitmoller.
- 3. Skip the turn at Nørre Vorupør and do it only at Klitmoller.
- 4. Make turns to shore in both places...






Thorough simulations have shown that a turn near **Nørre Vorupør** gives a profit and a loss with **Klitmoller**. In the end, I decided on variant number 2 and refined it in detail. It only remained to wait for


the effects. What will **Bonknhoot** do? Is it enough to overtake him? There was nothing else I could do, and I went to sleep to take care the passage at **Skagen** in the morning.

Great morning ②. **Bonknhoot** chose variant number 4 and lost the lead. My simulations and decisions turned out to be correct. **Skagen** was getting closer.


Cippalippa and NagaJolokia also sailed very well, taking 3rd and 4th position.



TOP 10 on Skagen ...




## ... and right after passing.



As predicted, after passing **Skagen**, the situation in the TOP 10 did not change until the finish line. **Bonknhoot** tried to attack my position twice more but it always ended up increasing my lead.

In the end, we finished the race in the order established earlier, of course I'm talking about the top ten.
