2024 QUARTERLY SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIPS

NOTICE OF RACE

The Sailonline Yacht Club (SYC) organizes the 2024 SPRINT Championship and relevant QUARTERLY Championships, open to SYC members, as well as to the entire Sailonline Racing Community. The following rules will apply:

1. Race calendar and Championships CODES

The 2024 SPRINT Championship (Code: 2024 SPRCH) will be run over **twelve** individual NOMINATED Races (three each quarter).





Each of the 2024 Quarterly SPRINT Championships (Codes: 2024 SRQ1 – 2024 SRQ2 – 2024 SRQ3 – 2024 SRQ4) will be represented by the series ranking of the **three** SPRINT Championship races of each relevant quarter.

Sailonline Operations will publish the SOL Calendar, advertising well in advance which races will be eligible for the SPRINT Championship and the Quarterlies in every single quarter.

2. Race Ranking system

In each Championship race SYC members will be scored as per World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2012/2024 Appendix A. (Low point system).

Non SYC members will be ranked as per "Position" for individual race prizes eligibility, but their points towards the series ranking will be attributed as DNC. Should they become members at a later date, the race result(s) where they were granted points as DNC will accrue to the series ranking as DNC.

If during 2024 a boat finishes at least one Championship race in SYC status, (i.e. accruing "Low points system" points) then such boat will enter the series rankings of the year (or the quarter) for that Championship, carrying all its results for that series ("Low points system" points or DNC).

3. Number of races valid for the series (discards)

2024 Annual SPRINT Championship

The best 10 results out of 12 for each boat will form the Series score for that boat (two discards). In case of ties comma A8 of World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A will be used to break the tie.





2024 Quarterly SPRINT Championships

All 3 results for each boat will form the Quarterly SPRINT Championship score for that boat (no discards). In case of ties comma A8 of World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A will be used to break the tie.

4. Racing rules

SOL's general rules as published in the platform's Forum apply to each Championship race, as to any race in SOL.

5. Protests

The Sailonline Protests Panel will be fully responsible for enforcing Protests, and their judgment will be without appeal. Protests procedures are set and available in the platform's Forum.

6. Prizes

All entrant boats (SYC members and non SYC members) will be eligible for prizes associated with individual races.

The Championship series rankings (Annual and Quarterly) and relevant prizes will include those entrants who completed at least one of the series races as SYC members.

2024 Annual SPRINT Championship

Second: Silver-like Large Medal with name of winning boat and Skipper

Third: Bronze-like Large Medal with name of winning boat and Skipper

Award Certificates will be issued to TOP 20 finishers

2024 Quarterly SPRINT Championships (each):

Winner: 2024 Quarterly SPRINT Championship PLAQUE with name of winning

Boat.

Second: Silver Medal virtual certificate

Third: Bronze Medal virtual certificate

Award Certificates will be issued to TOP 10 finishers





7. Prizes Delivery
