

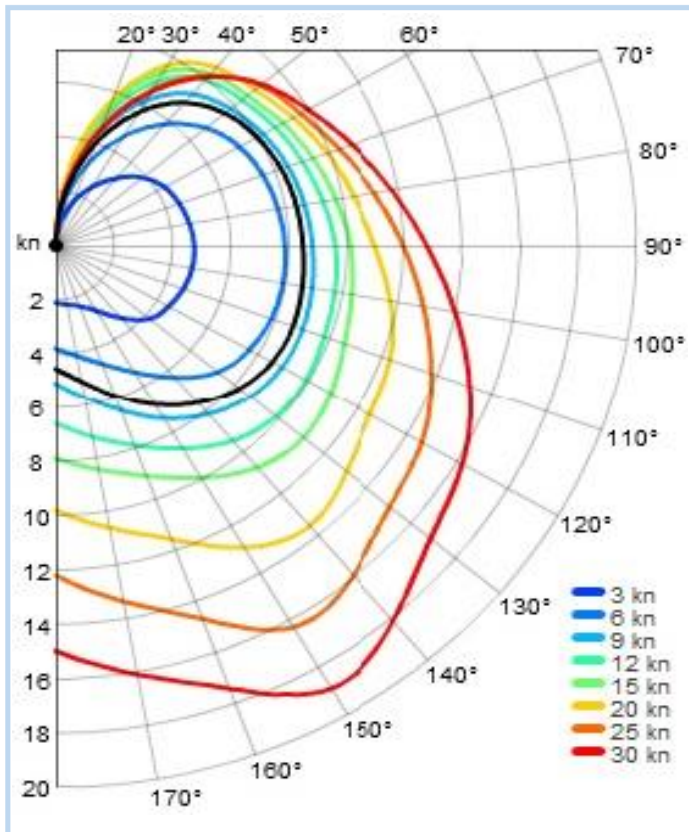

SOL's Class 40 saw its first outings in 2010.

In real life, the class came to being in 2004, as a level-rating, box-rule (12.19 x 4.5 x 3 m), single- or short-handed ocean racing solution positioned in between the Mini's and the IMOCA's.

Since those early days, the 40 has grown and grown in popularity with competitors, designers and builders worldwide, and has been a regular racer on SOL's virtual seas and oceans (which you can see via the link below).

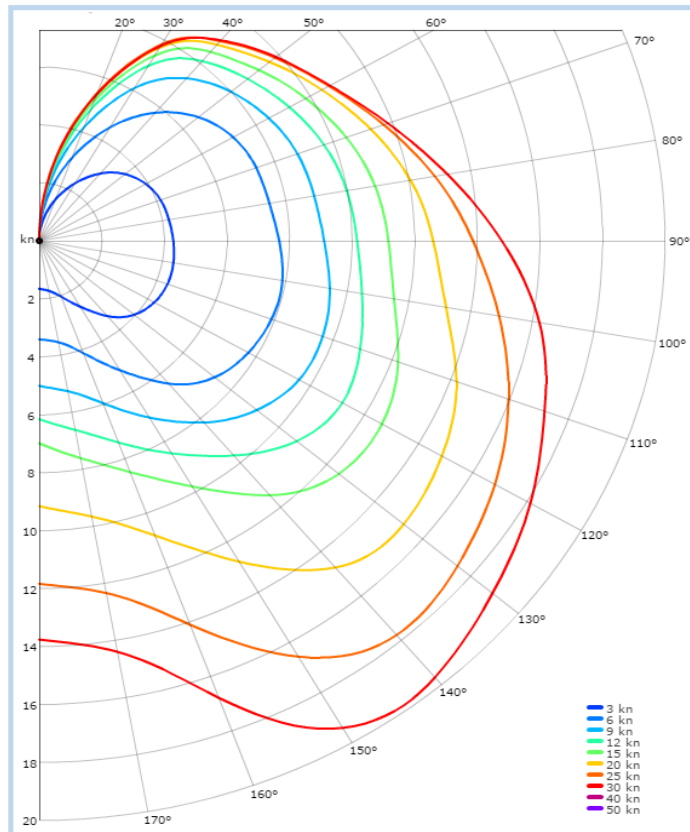


## Ker 40

Designed by Jason of the same name and built by McConaghy Boats, the Ker 40 is a high performance handicap racer and first hit the water in 2012. Very successful from the get-go, she was awarded Boat of the Year by America's Sailing World magazine the next year.

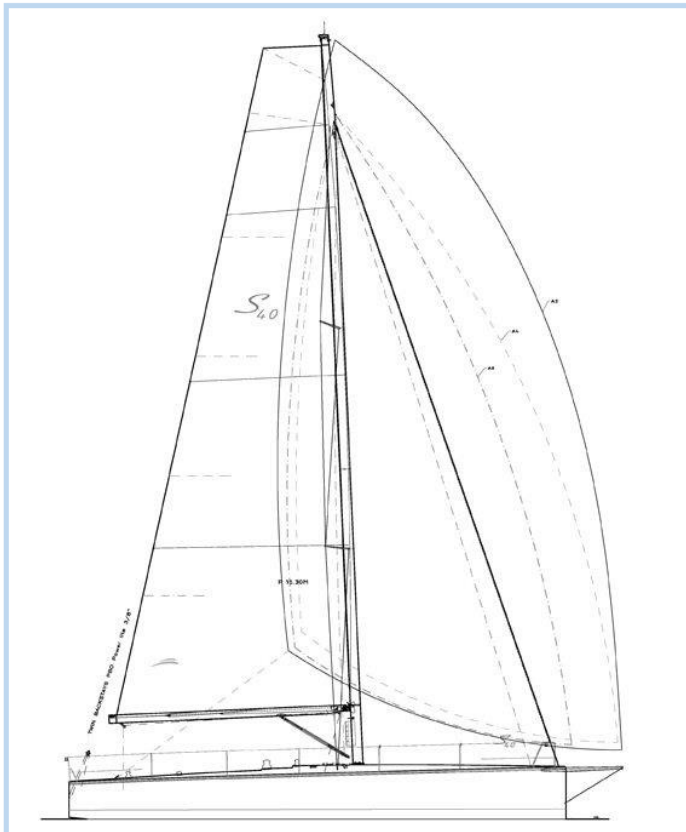

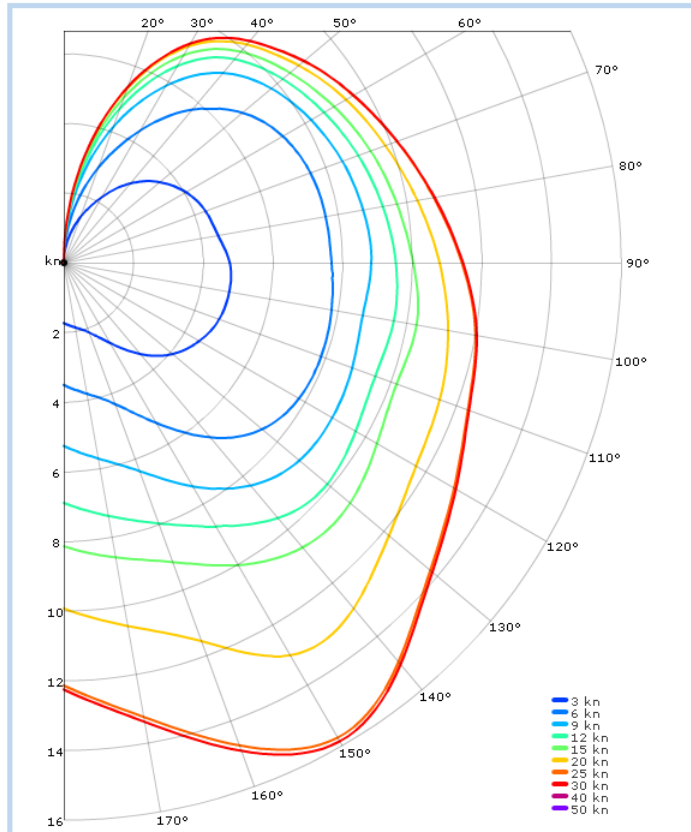


## SOTO 40
