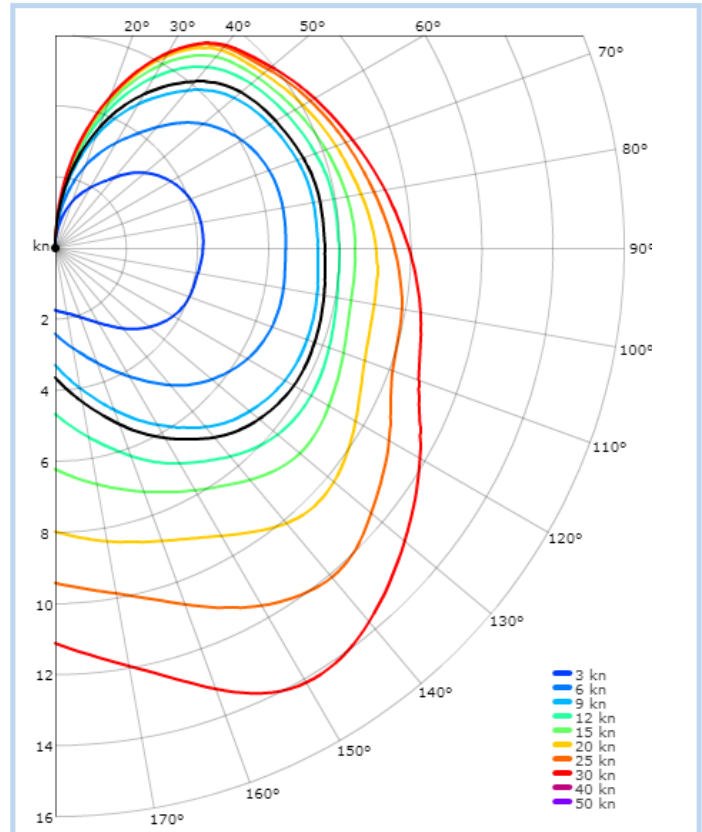

SOL RACE RECORD

Jeanneau, founded in 1957 by Henri Jeanneau as a powerboat business and built his first sailboat in 1964, have been series manufacturing sail- and powerboats since the start of the 1970s and until recently have perhaps been best known for their range of spacious Sun Odyssey cruising yachts.

However, today, their more spartan Sun Fast racing 'cruiser' range is also of considerable renown, in particular for the suitability of these designs for short-handed racing, and their recently (in 2019) launched 3300, smaller sister to the 2013 3600, has set tongues wagging again among all short-handers. No surprise then that she is Sailing World's 2020 Boat-of-the-Year. Like the 3600, she's a downwind flyer and on this occasion the SOL polar performance is based on data received from the organizers of the 2020 Newport-Bermuda race, which in 2020 was a virtual online event hosted by Sailonline.
