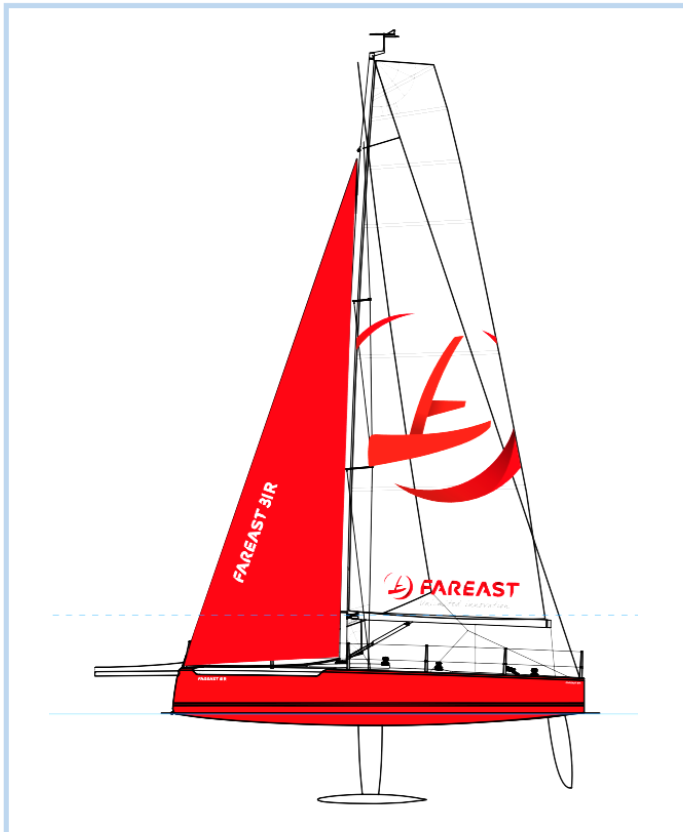


## Fareast 31R v2

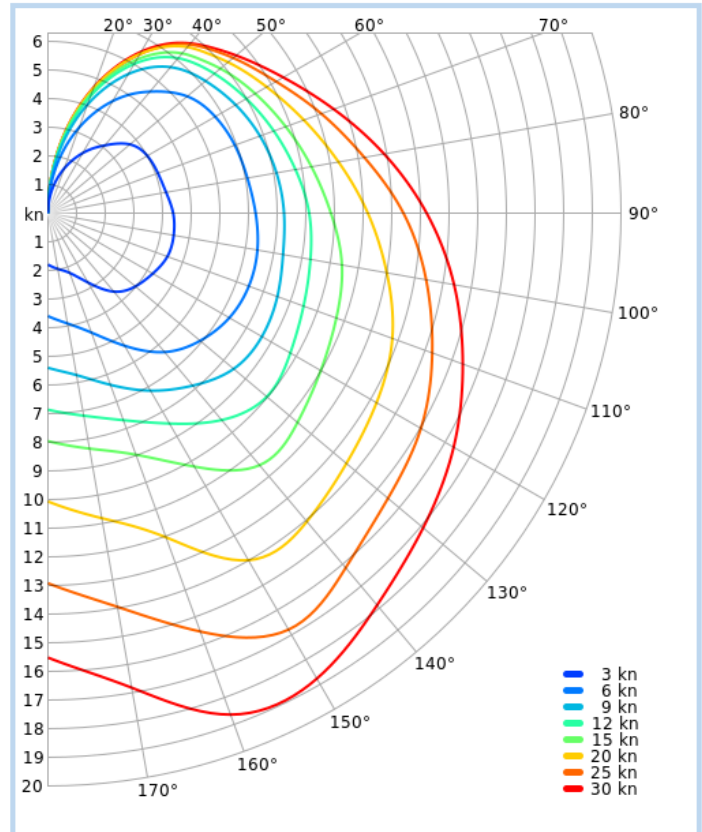

SOL RACE RECORD

SOL inducted the Shanghai Far East FRP Boats Company's FarEast 28R into her Boathall of Fame back in 2017, and then in 2020 was pleased to add the 31R to her racing pantheon. Unfortunately, an error in transcribing polar data required an early revision to this our Version 2.

A broadly similar craft to her smaller sister, the 31R is simply much more wellie of everything – 2.1m and 1200 Kg of keel instead of 1.75m and 600Kg, trying to keep 65 m<sup>2</sup> of white sails and 120 m<sup>2</sup> of gennaker upright, instead of 48m<sup>2</sup> and 80m<sup>2</sup> – except for hull weight, which being all-Carbon constructed is actually 20% lighter.

Like the 28R she is designed by Dutch Naval Architect Simonis Voogd, and given her stats it is not surprising that her polar is even more extreme than little sister's, with a top speed in excess of 19kn when the true wind is well abaft, but the apparent square. Race, race, race!
