

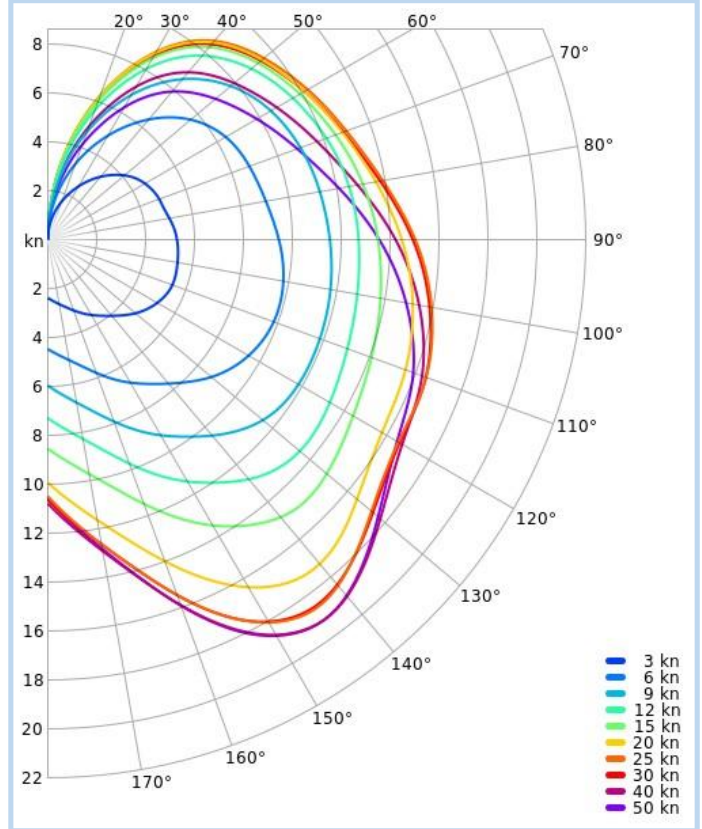

SOL RACE RECORD

Before he turned 40, as an offshore racing sailor and navigator Skip Novak had done it all – 4 Whitbread RTWs, Sydney Hobart and The Fastnet, but his desire for adventure had barely been whetted!

So, packing the racing in, in 1988 Skip commissioned his first Pelagic high-latitudes expedition yacht, aiming to sail (and climb and ski), and like the Starship Enterprise, "boldly, where no man had gone before".

Today (2024), Skip's Pelagic Expeditions operates two 77ft sister ships, and you can sign up as a crew on one of their scheduled voyages, provided you are younger than 70 and have £20 grand or so to spare. Alternatively enter a Sailonline high-latitudes race, and stay warm whilst you explore the lands of polar bears and penguins, aboard a virtual Pelagic 77 (or Amyr Klink's Paratii 2, our other expedition yacht).
