

Starting Conditions for SILVERRUDDER 2024

SAILONLINE will open the race on Monday 16 September at 08:30 UTC for Practice Racing, and, given the more predominant westerly winds in late September in Denmark, with an eastbound start direction, keeping Funen to port.

On the night of the Skipper's Briefing expected to be held on Thursday 19 September, 15:30 UTC, the official race direction will be announced, and as soon as possible thereafter, will then also be announced online via an "In-Race-Message" followed by a possible change of the racing waypoints sequence on the SOL chart.

HOWEVER:

The SILVERRUDDER TEAM reserves the right to change the starting conditions depending on the weather conditions, until "No Later Than Friday 20 September 05:00 UTC".

THAT MEANS:

As soon as possible AFTER 05:00 UTC on Friday 20 September there will be an "In-Race Message" announcing the **ACTUAL AND FINAL** starting direction followed by a possible change of the racing waypoints sequence on the SOL chart.

THEREFORE:

You are advised to refresh your screen (press F5) shortly after 05:30 UTC on Friday 20 September (allowing SOL time to update) and to **NOT** set DCs for the start at 08:30 UTC (10:30 local), which will be the start time for our Seascope 18s, **UNTIL YOU ARE ABSOLUTELY CERTAIN OF THE RACE DIRECTION!!!!**
