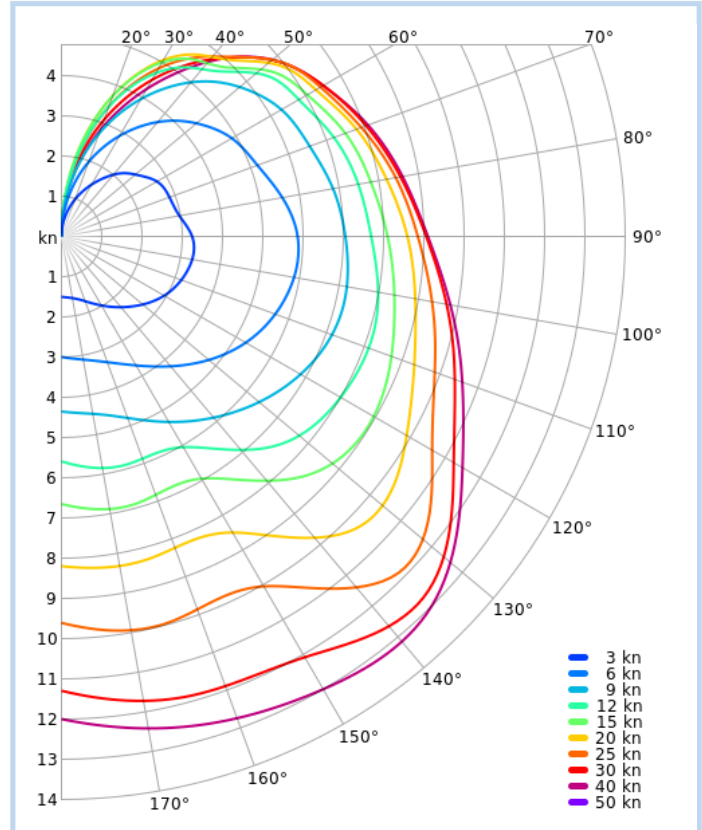

The most major innovation of the new generation of Mini 6.50's is of course foiling, and several years ago already SOLer Sebensa obtained a foiling polar from SEAir, a company better known for its petrol-powered craft and nowadays part of Beneteau.

SEAir's polar was incomplete, but more data has since come our way, and so without further ado, here is SOL's very own Mini 6.50 Foil. She may look like a bathtub, but she flies like a Valkyrie, and features all the other innovations of the new Mini's so well illustrated in the arrangement drawing from Arkema top left.
