






As long ago as 2005, legendary Kiwi boatbuilder Mick Cookson of inter-alia a number of America's Cup winning yachts, commissioned the Farr office to design a 50-footer with a canting keel with a bit more comfort and a bit more performance than a TP-52.

Since then, like many a boatbuilder, Cookson's business has not managed to stand the test of time, some of his boatbuilders now employed directly by Team New Zealand. But his Cookson 50 yachts have gone form strength to strength, still winning wherever they race, in original or modified form, becoming as legendary as the great man himself.
