It's a shame that Patrick was busy in the last 3 miles and couldn't defend his chances. It's also a shame that Flamingo made a careless mistake when rounding the final cape.

However, what a chaser's race that I didn't watch much!

9 skippers in 46 seconds (for a race that lasted 9 hours) !

I must congratulate them all, Siaki and Ryba, who shares the podium, rafa et Panpyc, arrived in the same second, Patrick, for the infernal pursuit, nakedgod, Vlieg and ForbanduCollet...

And Bravo to Flamingo who completes the top 10.

Very interesting and competitive race, and the planned tests will have to wait...
