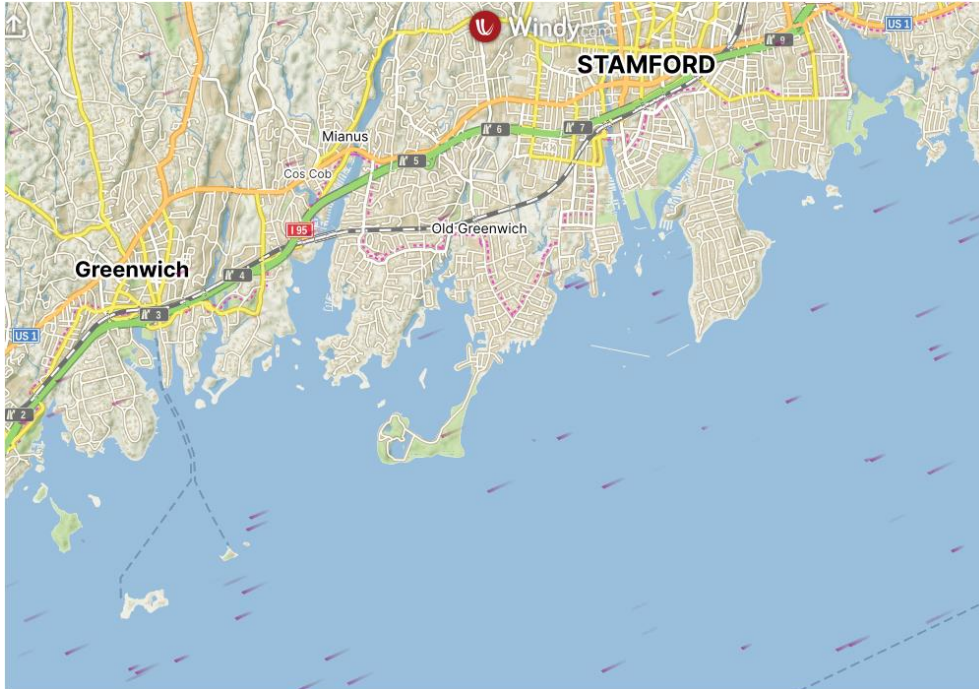
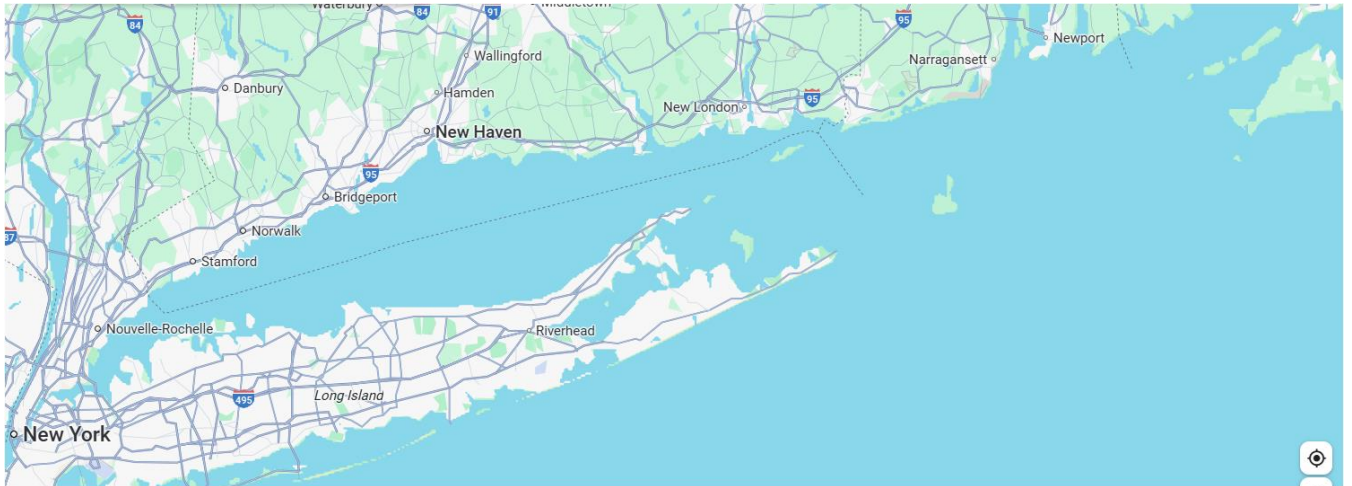

The MC38. From masthead to keel-tip: all carbon – all performance.

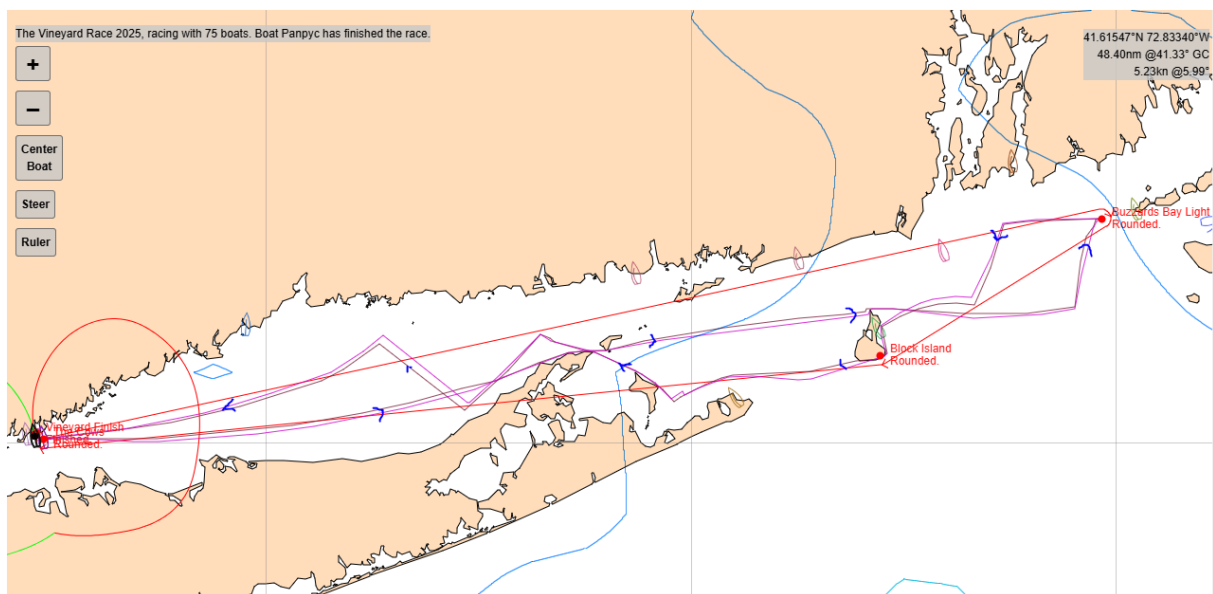

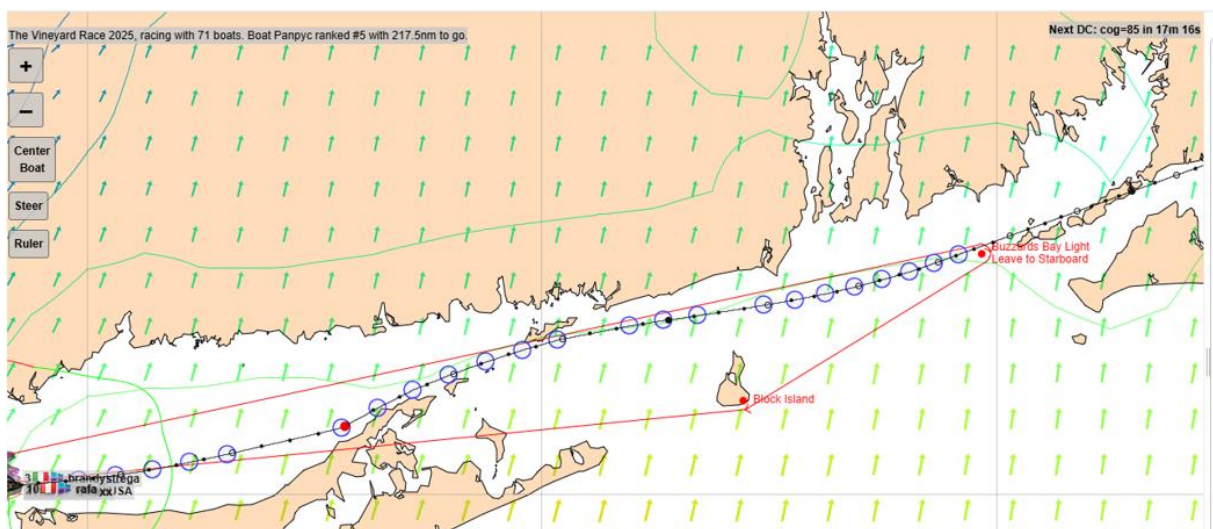

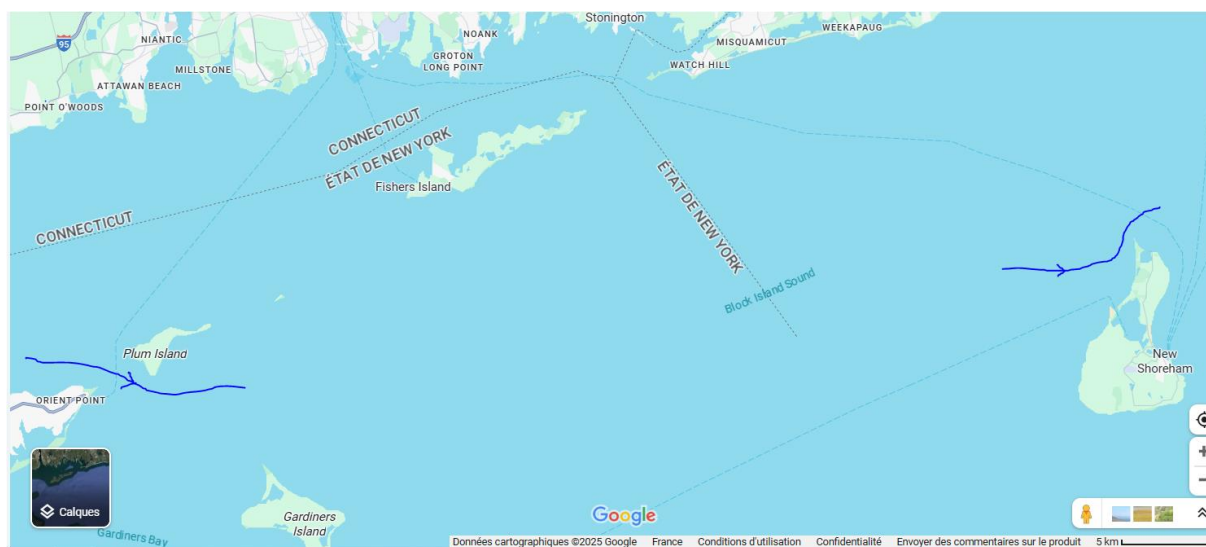
Round Trip of Panpyc and the Leaders



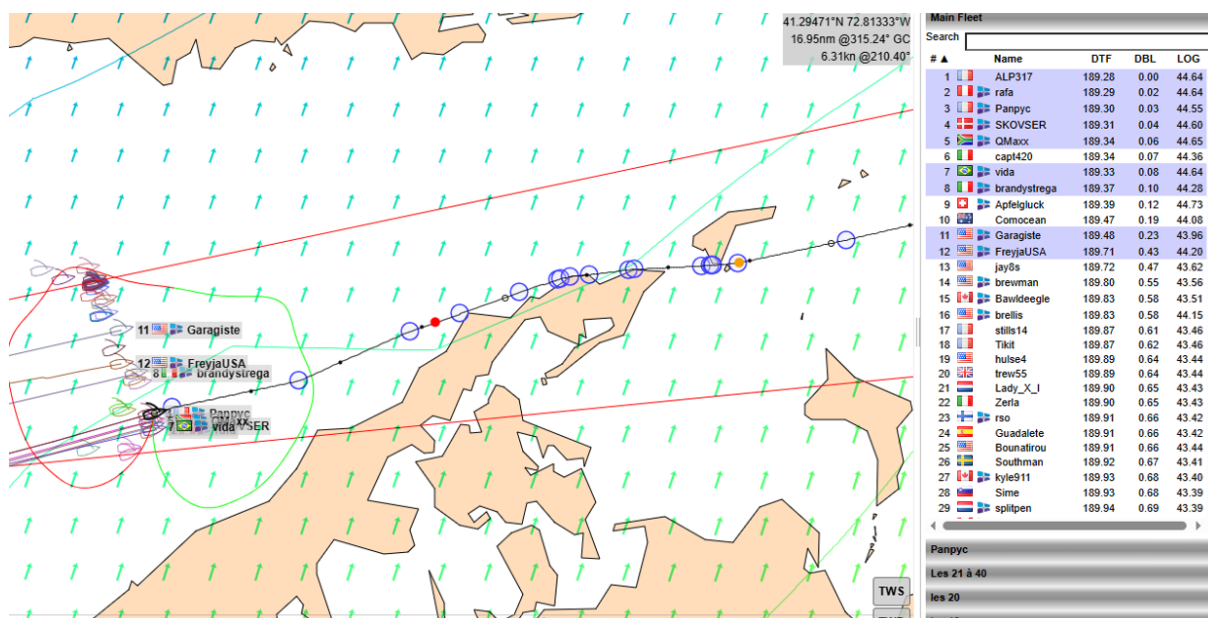

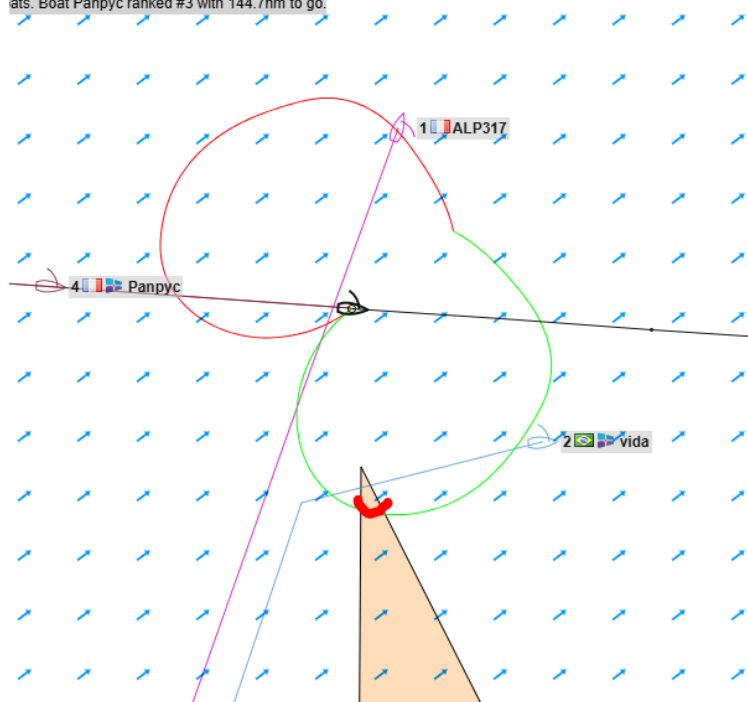
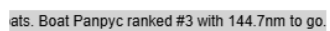

We pass Plum Island from the south and Block Island from the north

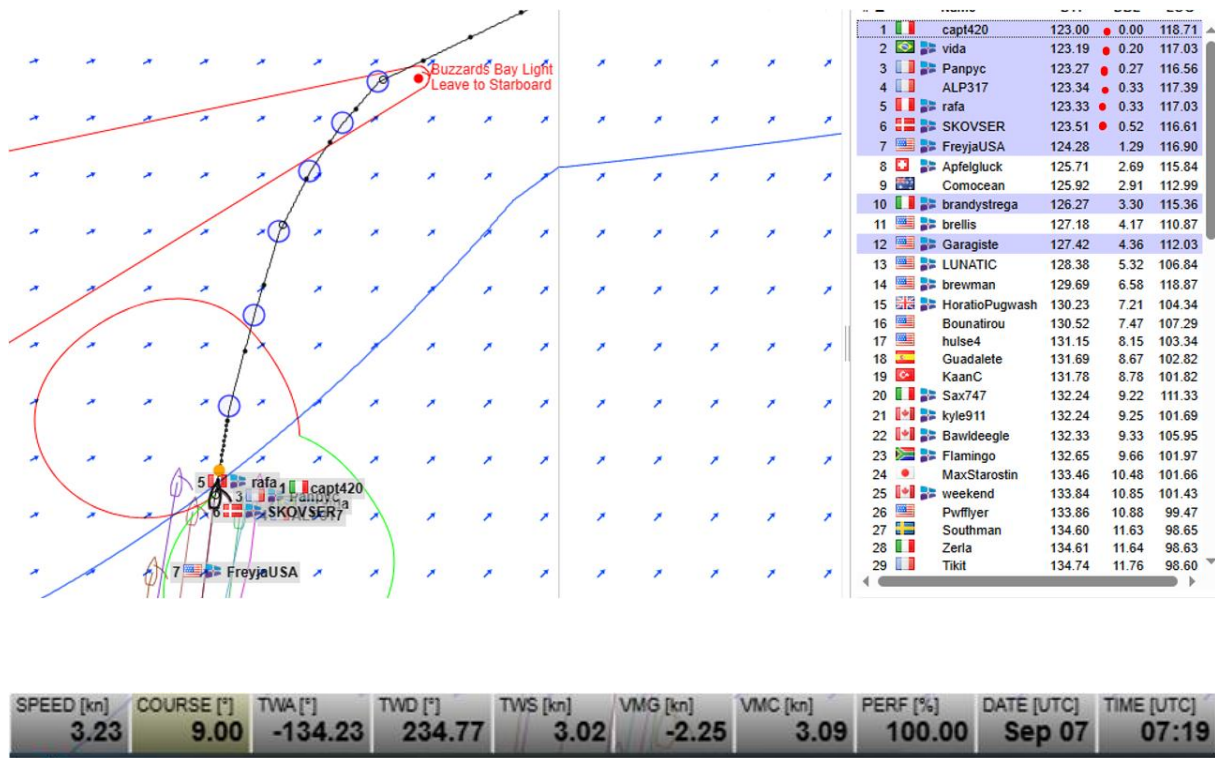


The Leaders are already taking shape, but with small gaps.

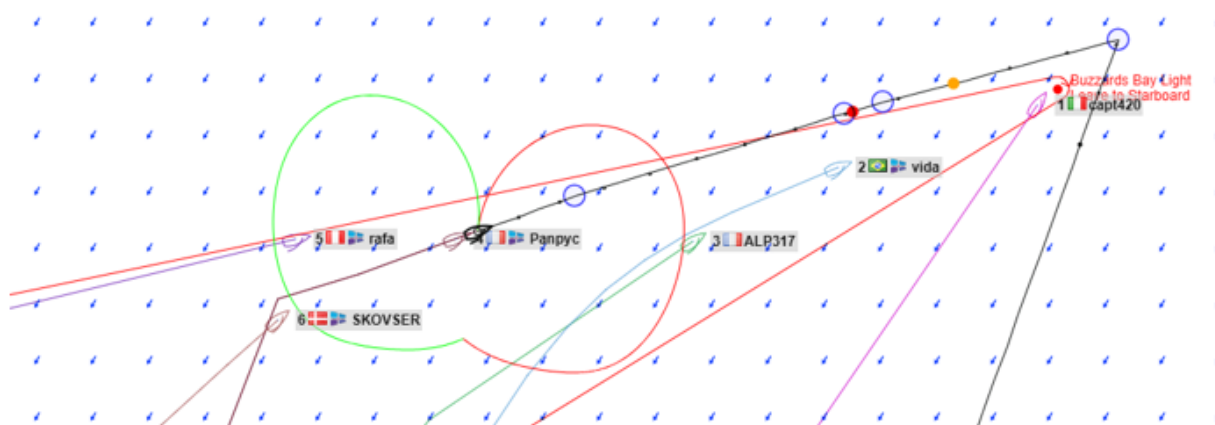

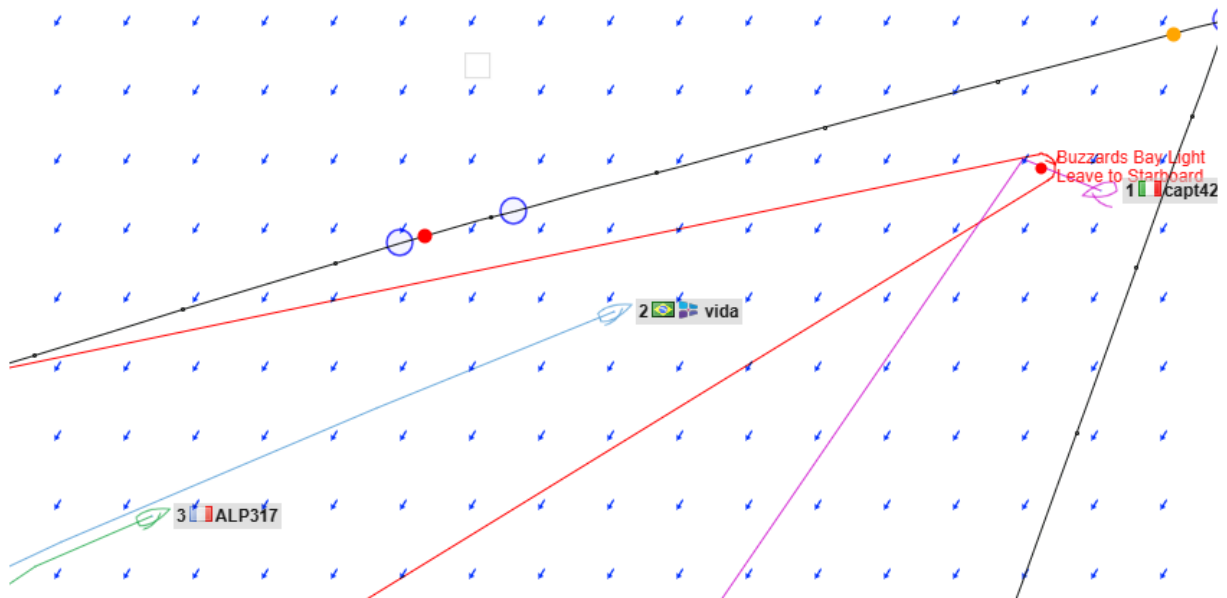

We are approaching Buzzards Bay Light, the first 7 have a small advantage, the wind has dropped

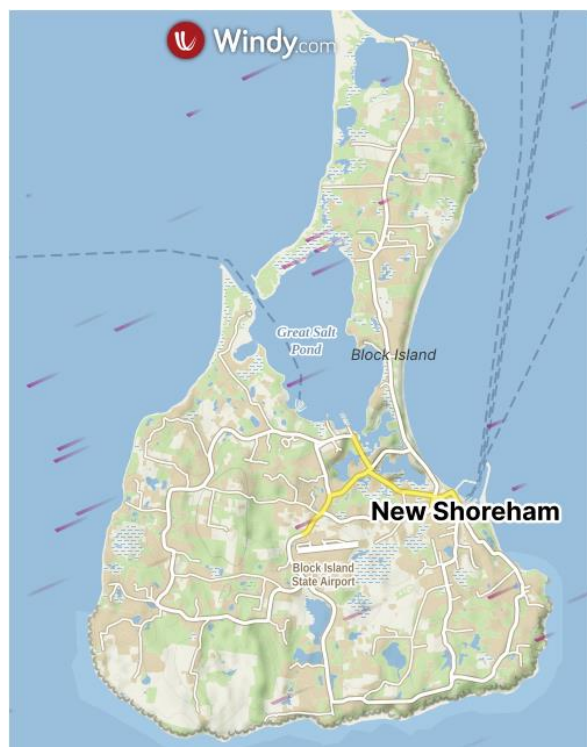

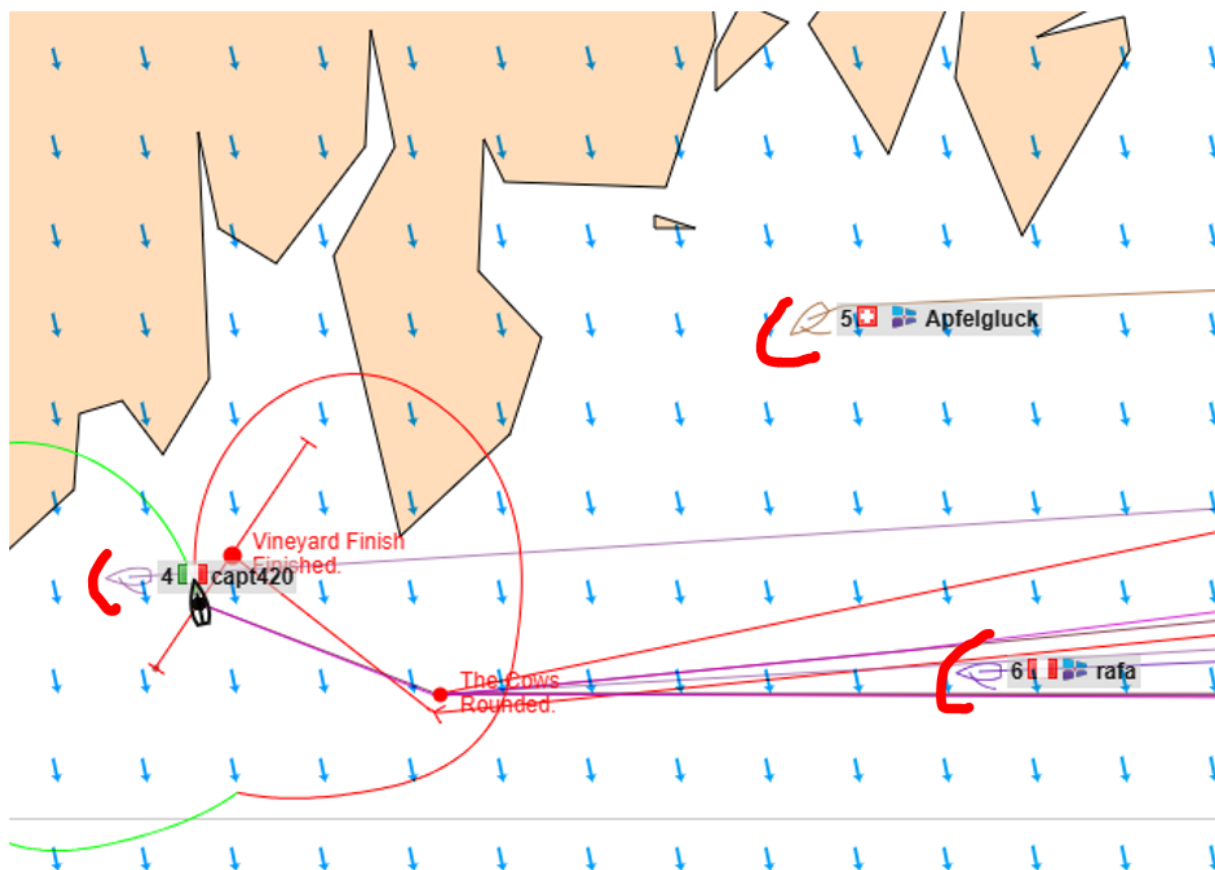
For the arrival 4 boats broke away
