As we got to 5-6 days to go, I started to look at how to get to a spot where I could get to the end on the correct side of the finish line, I had thought about going to the northwest of the line, and come back to it, but I found that I could go a bit to the east and have the last four weather updates to come back to the line. The rest of the people I was chasing were headed directly to the line, which I hoped would start to turn to the west to slow them down. The last two weather updates helped make a gentile curve to the end.

I was already shocked the last balloon race that I came in the Top 10. I am even more shocked now. I have been sailing online for 7-10 years, and never had this much go my way to make a competitive run to the finish.
